Getting to know the Dominican Republic

The official and spoken language is Spanish (English is also spoken in tourist areas). The official currency used is the Dominican peso, but the US dollar and the euro are also accepted.

For money transfers, you will find Western Union, Caribe Express and Money Gram. Visa credit cards can be used to withdraw money from ATMs. For large money transfers it is possible to do so with low-cost formulas by opening a bank account.

Opening of a current account

Foreigners who do not have residency in the country can open a bank account in the Dominican Republic with their passport. To open it you must be personally present at the bank, to date, it is still not possible to open an online current account.

In what currency can I open a current account?

Banks in D.R. they offer great advantages and services to their customers, as they give the possibility of opening a current account in different currencies:

current account in Dominican Pesos (minimum deposit for opening 5000 pesos)

current account in US Dollars (minimum deposit for opening 300 dollars)

current account in Euros (minimum deposit for opening 200 euros)



The climate in the Dominican Republic

The Dominican Republic essentially has two seasons and they are summer and autumn/spring, here there is no winter as in the "coldest" months of the year (from December to February) the temperature can reach a minimum of 20-22 degrees.

Since it is a tropical climate, the climate on the island is subject to sudden changes, suddenly it can happen that a downpour arrives for a few minutes and then clears up again.

the dry season

The dry season, runs from December to July, there are areas of the island that almost never rains in this season (the southern part of the island), however, in the northern part the rains are more frequent and the temperature is less suffocating. However, the temperature in the Dominican Republic never exceeds 35 degrees.

the cyclonic season

The rainy season, which runs from August to November, differs greatly between the north coast (more stable and less subject to bad weather) and the south coast. Therefore, those arriving in this period must be aware that they may encounter days of rain, humidity or, even if less likely, strong winds.



Tourist cities and towns where you can live in peace

Bayahibe: is located in the province of La Romana, and a tourist town well known by tourism, with beautiful Caribbean beaches.

Samana Peninsula

In the Samaná peninsula, there are some very beautiful and popular tourist towns and



they are: Samaná, Las Terrenas, Las Galeras and Sanchez.

Samaná: it is the largest town and is the provincial capital. Very popular with foreign tourists and domestic tourism.

Las Terrenas: the most beautiful town and known for tourism and for the many residents of many nationalities who live permanently. In short, it is a multi-ethnic village, where various cultures coexist.

Las Galeras: it is a very small town, in

development, located at the tip of the peninsula, chosen by tourists who want to spend a super quiet holiday.

Sanchez: this is the only one that is not frequented by tourists, a small fishing village (they catch prawns which are then sold throughout the island).

Sosua: tourist town on the sea, very popular with American tourists. It offers its guests many services and entertainment.



Cabarete: it is known throughout the world by surfing enthusiasts, the world championships are held here. Beautiful beaches, with rough seas and lots of wind.

Higuey

Another city is Higüey, less known than the previous ones, but which has developed its economy thanks to tourism from nearby Punta Cana.

Punta Cana/Bavaro: these are the two tourist locations in the Dominican Republic best known in the world, thanks to the all-inclusive holiday offers of the tourist villages.



Building a house in Dominican Republic

If the project is to build a house it is possible to carry it out, we can do it by entrusting you to a serious and tested company for the choice of land, for the practices and permits, for the design if you want to rely on an architect.

Once the building license has been obtained (the times are fast), it is possible to start the work.

If you are in the trade, you will be the ones to build your house yourself (together with the workers you contact).

The best solution, not being familiar with the place, is to rely on a valid construction company, which will build your house or villa, and in approximately 5-6 months it will be delivered to you turnkey, generally including the kitchen, appliances and bathrooms furnished in accordance with the your directions.



How much does it cost to build a house?

The cost is a very important point and varies according to different factors, therefore, a priori it is not possible to say a certain construction price.

Factors that affect the cost of construction:

- The city where it will be built
- The type of terrain (flat, hill)
- Land morphology
- Type of foundations
- The construction typology
- The type of finishing materials
- The project

Therefore, the indicative price for making a standard reinforced concrete construction is around 800 dollars per square meter. To know the real price, you need to know precisely the items listed above.

Traditional reinforced concrete construction

Construction with M2 construction system (5% saving compared to reinforced concrete construction)

Construction with LSF (Light Steel Frame) construction system, i.e. cold-formed steel profiles (savings of 8% compared to reinforced concrete construction)
